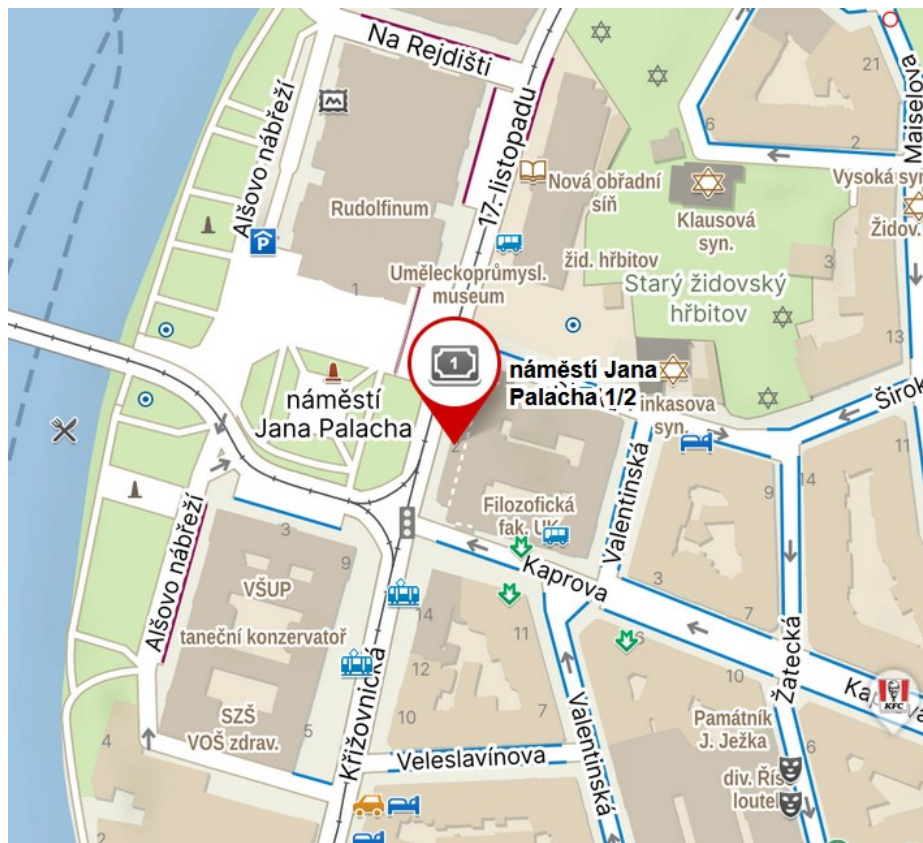
Public transport in Prague, journey from the airport to the city centre

Venue

- Faculty of Arts, Charles University // Filozofická fakulta, Univerzita Karlova (in Czech) Náměstí Jana Palacha 1/2
- The journey from the airport to the Faculty takes approximately 30 minutes. Use **trolleybus Nr. 59**, from the airport to metro station "Nádraží Veleslavín" (Line A – green), then take **metro to "Staroměstská" station** (approximately 10 minutes). The faculty building is right next to the metro station.

Presentation of conference papers

- The presentation of individual papers is planned to last 40 minutes (20 minutes for the presentation itself plus 20 minutes for discussion).
- We ask all the presenters to be punctual. It is advisable to upload your presentation in advance to the PCs provided in all seminar rooms. Student volunteers will assist with uploading and operating the PCs. They will also provide IT support if necessary. More detailed instructions will be sent to the chairs of the individual sections, who are responsible for managing the sessions (in particular, introducing the individual presenters, keeping track of presentation times, and moderating discussions).
- In the case of symposia, the exact time of the presentations is determined by the nature of the symposium (number of papers, etc.).
- There is no specific format for electronic presentation support; you can use standard pptx/pdf files.
